American Heart Association (AHA) Heartsaver (HS) Bloodborne Pathogen Provider Course

This course provides the necessary knowledge and skills by increasing the acute awareness and handling of potentially infectious material generally in any community or workplace setting. This course is an **annual OSHA-required course** for all of those who can reasonably expect to be exposed to blood-borne pathogens or other potentially infectious material (OPIM). The areas that **will be** covered include:

- Broad Discussion of Various Pathogenic Sources
- Bloodborne Diseases such as Hepatitis B (HBV) and HIV
- Skin-borne Diseases such as MRSA
- Air-borne Diseases such as TB
- Best Prevention especially proper handwashing and PPE
- Necessary treatment and reporting

This course is approximately 1 hour in length and students will receive a student workbook during class for use and reference and upon successful completion of this course will receive their AHA HS BBP Provider Certification Card.
